

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2024
IN THE
ROOSEVELT FIRE DISTRICT, IN THE
TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD,
NASSAU COUNTY, NEW YORK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election of the qualified voters of the Roosevelt Fire District (hereinafter called the “Fire District”), in the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, will be held at Fire District Headquarters, 56 West Centennial Avenue in Roosevelt, New York, in the said Fire District, on **Tuesday, March 26, 2024**. The polls shall open at 2:00 o’clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) and shall remain open until 9:00 o’clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) or as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their votes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Fire District on February 17, 2024, the following Proposition will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Fire District for approval or disapproval:

PROPOSITION

Shall each of the following described Bond Resolutions adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Roosevelt Fire District, in the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, on February 17, 2024, be approved?:

(a) authorizing the construction of a single story, approximately 8,000 square foot fire station on Fire District property located at 51 Park Avenue, Roosevelt, New York, substantially as described in the report prepared for the Fire District by JCM Architecture, P.C., including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus and ancillary or related site, demolition and other work required in connection; stating the estimated maximum cost thereof is \$7,772,672, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof; appropriating said amount therefor, including the appropriation of the aggregate amount of \$2,000,000 from the Fire District's existing capital reserve funds heretofore established, which is hereby approved; authorizing the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$5,772,672 to finance the balance of said appropriation; and providing for the levy and collection of taxes to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same become due and payable, and

(b) authorizing the acquisition of a fire truck, including apparatus and equipment used in connection therewith, to be used by the Fire District; stating the estimated maximum cost of the Project is \$2,500,000, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof; appropriating said amount therefor; authorizing the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$2,500,000 to finance said appropriation; and providing for the levy and collection of taxes to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same become due and payable.

The Proposition shall appear upon the ballot to be used for voting in substantially the following form:

SHALL THE BOND RESOLUTIONS OF ROOSEVELT FIRE DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF HEMPSTEAD, ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 17, 2024, (i) authorizing (a) the construction of a single story, approximately 8,000 square foot fire station on Fire District property located at 51 Park Avenue, Roosevelt, New York, substantially as described in the report prepared for the Fire District by JCM Architecture, P.C., including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus and ancillary or related site, demolition and other work required in connection, at the estimated maximum cost of \$7,772,672 and (b) the acquisition of a fire truck, including apparatus and equipment used in connection therewith, to be used by the Fire District, at the estimated maximum cost of \$2,500,000; (ii) stating that the estimated total cost of said new fire station and fire truck is \$10,272,672 and appropriating said amount therefor, including the appropriation of \$2,000,000 from the Fire District's existing Capital Reserve Funds heretofore established, which is hereby approved; and (iii) authorizing the issuance of bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$8,272,672 to finance a part of said appropriation and providing for the levy and collection of taxes to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same become due and payable, BE APPROVED?

All residents of the Fire District who were duly registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections on or before Tuesday, March 4, 2024, shall be eligible to vote at said Special Election.
